Pray for our upcoming men's breakfast on April 5th.



Membership Application and Membership Transfers to Glencross

Our Membership Application/Transfer process is as follows. If you have been attending Glencross for at least 6 months, have been baptized, and would like to become a member at Glencross the process is as follows:

- Pick up a Membership Application Form along with the guidelines for writing out your testimony from the table in the foyer
- Hand the completed Membership Application and written testimony to a Ministerial Member
- Ministerial will review your Application and Testimony and arrange for a visit
- After approval of your Membership Application there will be a Service arranged where you share your testimony with the congregation.

Excess Funds Disbursement

Church Council met to discuss the suggestions that were received from the membership on how to disburse the excess funds from 2024. With the recommendations from the Ministerial Board, we have come up with the following list of projects to support:

- \$25,000 for Prairie Crossroads School to use toward their new school building
- \$15,000 for a Glencross Church Ministry Scholarship in effort to develop a pastor from within our own congregation
- \$10,000 for Pembina Valley Bible Camp
- \$10,000 for EMMC projects: Shipyard building project and Little Belize roof project
- \$7,000 for our Youth Program
- \$2,500 for VBS to reduce the need to fundraise for a couple years

Total disbursement: \$69,500

The plan is to distribute these funds over the next couple of months. If you have questions regarding any of these projects or the allocation of the excess funds, please talk to either Paul or anyone from Council.
